


## Orin Kramer

Orin S. Kramer manages Boston Provident, L.P., a private investment fund. He was Chairman of the New Jersey State Investment Council, the Robert F. Kennedy Center, and his regional Community Chest. He is a board member of the Climate Reality Project, chaired by former Vice President Gore. He has served on the boards of a number of financial services firms, public and private.

In 2011, Gov. Cuomo appointed him to the New York State Council of Economic and Fiscal Advisors. In 2007, he was appointed by the Pennsylvania State Treasurer as a member of the Financial Asset Management Commission, which reviewed the State's investment practices. In 1995, he was designated by the Secretary of Treasury to serve as a member of the Advisory Commission on Financial Services. He was named by President Clinton as a member of the Commission to Study Capital Budgeting. In 1992, he served as a coordinator of President-elect Clinton's transition team on financial services issues. In 1990, he was appointed by the Governor of California as executive director of the California Commission on Rate-making for Workers Compensation Insurance. In 1986, he served as vice-chairman and executive director of a special commission appointed by Governor Cuomo to study the liability insurance crisis and civil justice reform, and he co-authored the New York DeWind Commission report on product deregulation for banks. Mr. Kramer has published two books and a number of studies on the financial services industry. He has taught financial institutions law at Columbia Law School.



From 1981 to 1983, Mr. Kramer was a member of the financial institutions group at the management-consulting firm of McKinsey & Co. From 1977 to 1981, he served as Associate Director of the White House Domestic Policy Staff. Previously, Mr. Kramer had been an associate with the law firm of Simpson Thacher & Bartlett and executive director of the New York State Commission on Living Costs and the Economy. He received his B.A. from Yale College and J.D. from Columbia Law School.
